A new edition of *Feng Shui Action Movie Roleplaying* is in the works and we're seeking input from gamers worldwide. In this early phase of the game's development, we are looking for playtesters to do the following:

1. Sign up with Atlas Games' Special Ops demo team organization:



2. Using only the rules, character archetypes, and information found in the Atlas Games edition of the *Feng Shui* RPG, play the *Baptism of Fire* scenario with your group.

3. Collect feedback from your players and add your own experience running the game.

4. Submit your feedback with your Special Ops ID number to playtest@atlas-games.com.



Frequently Anticipated Questions

Q: But I've played *Feng Shui* a lot since it first came out in 1996. Can I give you my feedback from that?

A: We very much need two types of feedback:

- Observations and feature requests based on your **past *Feng Shui* play experiences**, especially if you played the game for a long time. Some groups played for a period far in excess of the original development window. Their observations will prove helpful in tuning the game for prolonged play.
- Reports from a **standardized playtest** reflecting what's actually in the main game, unfiltered by years of memory. Here we're not only looking for people who have been fans for years, but also bringing in new players and those who may have had the book on their shelf but not played it recently. Games have grown, developed, changed, and seen multiple editions over the years, and all of this has an impact on how you run the game when you go back to the basics.

Q: Why do I need to sign up with **Special Ops**? Can't I just send you an email?

A: **Special Ops** is our crack team of volunteers and demonstrators. We feel, as playtester GMs, you should be included

in their number. In addition, Special Ops allows us to manage something as large as a public alpha playtest in a reasonably sane way.

Q: Can I discuss the playtest on the Atlas Games forums?

A: We love it when people talk about our games and share their experiences on our forums! That's why we have them, after all. For the *Feng Shui* playtesting, however, we need you to send your feedback and comments *directly to us* via the playtesting process. If you have questions about the game or need some help understanding it, the forums continue to be a great resource for that. That said, even finding you have trouble understanding a rule, or aren't sure what a specific schtick should do, counts as playtest feedback and should be reported to us.

Q: How long is the playtest?

A: We're conducting the initial playtest through **October 31st**. Playtesters who take part in the alpha playtest will be informed via Special Ops about the next major playtest rounds, including being asked to test new stuff!
